

## Appendix I Category and Specification of Guard Instruments

Guard Instrument Category	Specification	Function
Leg Shackles	Made of metal, plastic or other suitable materials. The recommended weight limit is 2 kilograms, but if necessary, it may be increased to 3 kilograms. For juvenile persons receiving disposition, the recommended weight limit is one kilogram, but may be increased to two kilograms, if necessary.	The device is used to restrain the ankles of the persons receiving disposition, in order to control their movements.
Handcuffs	Made of metal, plastic or other suitable materials, weighing no more than half a kilogram.	The devices are used to restrain the wrists of the persons receiving disposition, or to connect them with other suitable fixtures, in order to control their movements.
Chains	Made of metal, plastic or other suitable materials. The recommended weight limit is 2 kilograms, but if necessary, it may be increased to 3 kilograms. For juvenile persons receiving disposition, the recommended weight limit is one kilogram, but may be increased to two kilograms, if necessary.	The device is placed around the waists of the persons receiving disposition and is interlocked or connected to other suitable fixtures in order to restrain the freedom of movement of the persons receiving disposition and to control their activities.
Zip Ties	Made of plastic or other suitable materials.	The device is used to restrain the wrists or ankles of the persons receiving disposition in order to control their movements.
Other guard instruments approved by the Ministry of Justice	The categories and approval procedures for instruments, other than leg shackles, handcuffs, chains and zip ties that are used to restrict the movement of persons receiving disposition, shall be determined by the Ministry of Justice.
